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
# ABOUT US

## Who We Are

The Early Childhood Enrichment (ECE) System was established by the South Dakota Department of Social Services, Child Care Services (CCS) to meet the growing demand for early childhood and school-age training, to help recruit and retain quality child care providers, as well as to encourage and support program quality across the state of South Dakota. The ECE System is supported through five regional offices located throughout the state.

The ECE System offers a systematic approach to providing early childhood and school-age education services and technical assistance. Services are offered to all child care and school age professionals, parents, and others involved in the day-to-day care of children.

# CREDENTIAL OPPORTUNITIES

## Child Development Associate

*Preparing individuals to meet the developmental, emotional and educational needs of young children.*

The Child Development Associate (CDA) credential is a nationally recognized early childhood professional credential administered by the Council for Professional Recognition. Providers who pursue the CDA credential learn to demonstrate their ability to nurture young children's physical, social, emotional and intellectual growth.

The South Dakota CDA training program supports educators interested in earning the National CDA Credential by increasing the availability of early childhood professional training and mentorship across South Dakota to increase competencies and skills to impact South Dakota's youngest citizens.



## School-Age Care Credential

This opportunity empowers School-Age Professionals across South Dakota who support youth in summer programs and before and after-school programs to advance their careers. This newly launched opportunity is available in two options, which include the South Dakota School-Age Care (SAC) Certificate or full Credential.

The SD SAC Certificate is a state-recognized professional development award for 38 hours of youth-specific training, which includes on-demand accessible training. This certificate is a pathway to the SD SAC Credential, which includes 120 hours of youth-specific training, and signifies you have demonstrated competence in caring for school-age children that aligns with the South Dakota Core Knowledge and Competencies for Early Childhood and School-Age Educators.



# COACHING & TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

## Coaching & Technical Assistance

All Technical Assistance (TA) is focused on increasing the knowledge and confidence of the provider to promote and support optimal development for every child. Social Emotional development is critical for optimal development and is a major component of all Technical Assistance programs.

TA is offered through consultation and coaching, which provides support, education and resources. TA can support a provider's challenge or an opportunity for strengthening skills through support, education, and resources. Through coaching or technical assistance, providers can increase their confidence in implementing quality care practices.


## Director 360 Program



The 360 Support Program is a professionally guided program that provides tools, technical assistance, education and support to child care directors.

# EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

## Regional Trainings

The Early Childhood Enrichment (ECE) System offers a variety of evidence and research-based professional development opportunities. Trainings are accessible to child care providers across the state through in-person, online and on-site delivery. Trainings are offered to not only meet licensing and registration requirements, but to also improve the quality of care.

## Statewide On-Demand Trainings

These on-demand training opportunities are available to child care professionals and school-age professionals in South Dakota. ## Level I Orientation

All new child care providers working in a registered or licensed child care or school-age program are required to complete Level I orientation training within 90 days of hire.

## Level II Orientation

Level II training is an on-demand series for staff working in a registered or licensed child care or school-age programs. Must be taken within the first 5 years of employment.

## Temperament Program

The Temperament Program is a collaborative approach between parent(s), child care providers and the educator to understand a child's temperament. When a child's temperament is understood, it is easier to meet the child's needs in order to encourage the child's development. The temperament Program is available in Region 3 & 5.


## Social Emotional Program

The SD Early Childhood Enrichment (ECE) System offers the Social Emotional (SE) program to support child care providers and parents involving children who exhibit challenging behaviors or developmental concerns. The Social Emotional program is offered in Regions 1, 3 & 5.

### Supports available include:

- Developmental Milestones and Screenings
- Onsite Observations
- Identifying Community Resources

ECE provides education, resources and technical assistance for the prevention of suspension and expulsion practices in early childhood programs.




## Pathways to Professional Development






